

Student Citizenship Certification:

To qualify for Florida resident financial aid programs the student must be a U.S. citizen or an eligible non-citizen. Please check one of the following. If neither apply, you are not eligible for Florida resident financial aid.

I am a U.S. citizen

I am an eligible non-citizen (please attach a copy of the front and back of your resident alien card or appropriate visa)

Generally, you are considered an eligible non-citizen if you are one of the following:

- U.S. permanent resident or conditional permanent resident with a Permanent Resident Card (formerly known as an Alien Registration Receipt Card or "Green Card")
- Other eligible non-citizen with an Arrival-Departure Record (from the Department of Homeland Security showing any one of the following designations: "Refugee," "Asylum Granted," "Indefinite Parole," "Humanitarian Parole," or "Conditional Entrant" or with one of the following visa codes:
  - o A, E, GH-1BH-1C, I, KL, N, MTO 1-7D-1, R, S, T, U, JCE
- A citizen of the Republic of Palau (PW), the Republic of the Marshall Islands (MH), or the Federated States of Micronesia (FM).
